## Call for applications: CEiC

- Applications are now invited for the positions of Co-Editor-in-Chief (CEiC) for the journal *Environmental and Resource Economics (ERE)*.
- *ERE* is moving to have three Co-Editors-in-Chief (CEiC).
- At least one CEiC is currently sought although more than one may be appointed in the current round.
- Each CEiC serves a three-year term, with one person rotating off each year.
- An Appointments Committee (details below) can extend the term of a CEiC by a further three-year period.

- Applications close on the **15<sup>th</sup> September 2023**
- Applications should consist of a CV and covering letter explaining the applicant's suitability for appointment as CEiC (please clarify that this is the position being applied for and not Managing Editor).

## CEiC Appointment process

- All applications will be passed on to the ERE Editorial Board
- The ERE Editorial Board prepare a longlist for the Appointments Committee
- The Appointments Committee consists of at least 50% ERE Editorial Board members (including at least one serving CEiC), the EAERE President, the Publisher's delegate, plus several esteemed leaders from the field
- The Appointments Committee will consider the longlist and invites a shortlist of prospective CEiCs to interview
- The Appointments Committee then appoints the new CEiC(s)

# Call for Applications: Managing Editor (ME)

- Applications are also sought for a Managing Editor (ME)
- The ME would act as academic assistant to the CEiCs
  - Monitoring editor invitations and performance.
  - Monitoring reviewer invitations, acceptances and deadlines.
  - Monitoring the progress of each paper through peer review.
